1. Basic Life Support (BLS) and CPR Training

Our Basic Life Support (BLS) and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) training program aligns with American Heart Association (AHA) standards, offering essential life-saving skills for a range of scenarios.

CPR Certification: Hands-on training for CPR techniques on adults, children, and infants, including chest compressions, rescue breathing, and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED).

Emergency Response Skills: Education on assessing emergencies, activating emergency response systems, and performing critical first aid.

Healthcare Provider BLS: Specialized BLS training for healthcare professionals, focusing on teamwork, critical thinking, and real-time response in healthcare settings.

Flexible Learning Options: In-person and onsite available to accommodate different scheduling needs.

2. Overdose Response Training

Prevention and Community Awareness: Information on substance use, risk reduction strategies, and resources for further support.
